

OUR HISTORY

In 1953, Dr. Charles Fuller, a well-known Gospel radio preacher from *The Old Fashioned Revival Hour* was invited to lead a revival at the Ryman Auditorium. After seeing

so many homeless men on the streets of Nashville, Fuller returned the money he received for speaking to be used for the establishment of a place that would care for the city's homeless. In 1954, Nashville Union Mission, today known as Nashville Rescue Mission, opened its doors to the homeless and hurting in the community. Our mission is to provide hope for today, hope for tomorrow, and hope for eternity to the hungry, homeless, and hurting.
